With more people looking to make money working from home, trying to make money blogging is a growing pursuit. I've been blogging constantly since 2009. After more than 11 years, it's been a long and wonderful road. In this post, I want to share how much bloggers can really do and. It took me 20 years to build a portfolio that generates over \$250,000 a year in passive and semi-passive income. It took only five years to build the same income blogging. Why is that? Reasons why you should try Blogging 1) Low barriers to entry. Depending on where and when you buy, you need \$1-\$2M in capital to generate \$50,000 in net operating income with property here in San Francisco. It takes at least \$1m in capital to generate \$20,000 a year in dividends from the S&P 500 index. With both asset classes, you can also lose the main. With blogging, it costs as little as \$2.95/month to run a website and you get a domain name for free. If things don't go well, all you've lost is your time and a minimum amount of money. 2) The curve of enormous demand. Samual financial can theoretically reach three billion people online through search engines, word of mouth, organic promotion, and advertising. If that happens, I'll be worth billions and take each of you to a steak dinner! However, in real estate, you can only lock in one set of tenants and raise the rent once a year. On the stock market, you are a passive investor with no control over dividend payments or other strategic management decisions. With a retail store, you can only capture traffic in the neighborhood. The Internet is growing in usage and size every day. 3) Operating lever. Since the costs are generally fixed (hosting and domain registration), rowing more traffic and revenue you get. It is not unusual to earn 80% + profit margins operating as a professional blogger, depending on how much you pay. Very few companies can compare. Now that I've convinced pro blogging is the best profession on Earth, maybe you're interested in knowing how much you can actually do? Before we get to the money, let me first point out the types of best suited to succeed as a professional blogger. People best suited for Blogging 1) Creatives who enjoy writing. You can't tell you have to like to write. You don't have to be a good writer, you just have to enjoy writing as much as you enjoy eating a juicy double cheeseburger with fries with garlic cheese. After a day of not writing, i get this insatiable need to be left alone for at least a few hours to write. 2) Creatives who enjoy connecting with others. One of my favorite joys is mocking with smart people who have an opinion on the topics I write about. For those who want to be able to live more lives to experience more of the world, blogging comes very close to life. There is a great online community that is generally very supportive. If you used to have a pen friend, used for bbs, or enjoy meeting unique people, blogging is for you. 3) Someone with an entrepreneurial spirit. There is a huge difference between being a freelance writer, a journalist, and a pro blogger. A freelance writer is paid per article and is always looking for his next assignment. A journalist covers a fight and is paid by an employer. A blogger gets paid nothing per article, and you have to think long-term to earn advertising and partnership revenue. Blogger pro is Chief Marketing Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Chief Designer, and Chief Executive Officer. As a true entrepreneur, there would be no other way because you are in control of your destiny. You eat what you kill. And there's nothing more satisfying than growing something out of nothing. 4) People who always want freedom to choose. Most people are unhappy with their jobs because they are limited in what they can do. They have a boss they might want, but they don't like being told what to do. They may have unqualified micromanagers to drive them crazy. Or, they could work at a company that produces a product or service that adds no significant value to the world. When you have the freedom to choose, even if you choose the wrong, you feel much happier. In many ways, the feeling of being a blogger is very much like the feeling of having financial freedom. 5) People who think they have the power to make positive changes. Every single blogger I know started their website because they were unhappy about something in their lives. I started Financial Samurai during the depths of the financial crisis because I was worried and confused. My net worth took a 35% beating, but I thought I could get myself out of the doldrums and help others who were suffering rebuild their wealth. Since 2009, millions of people have been able to improve their financial well-being by reading a personal finance site. My own wealth is much greater thanks to careful analysis and online responsibility. How Much Can You Do Blogging? The people who make the most money blogging money tend to be the ones who have gone into blogging because they mainly enjoy writing and connecting people and then figure out the business side of things. The people who do the least amount blogging tend to be the ones who first blog to make money. Their content has no spirit, which means that their content is barely read or shared. In general, you can do anywhere from 1-10 cents a page view. In other words, if you have 100,000 page views per month, you can make \$1,000-\$10,000 a month. The range is wide because how much you can do blogging depends on your niche and demographic audience. If the entire audience is under 13 because you write about cats for teens, then you probably aren't going to make as much money as someone who writes about planning retirement for Baby Boomers. That said, there are a lot of examples of entertainment sites and YouTube channels that respond to a younger population that makes millions. Below is a graph of how much you can do blogging if you generated 1,210,543 page views in a month at a \$13.5 revenue per thousand impressions. Example of actual advertising income based on click. The moon so far is 21 days. RPM = ~ \$13.5 or 1.35 cents/view page. Compare Blogging Income to Average Household Income Given the national household income is about \$64,000 per year, starting in 2020, simple math states that if you can generate 64,000 to 640,000 per month in pageviews, you will be able to quit your job and support a median family in underwear through your writing efforts. But of course you should know by now that it is never a good idea to quit your job without having a livable income stream on the side. Always negotiate a separation through a layoff, so you can have a long enough financial track to build your website traffic and revenue into something meaningful. Have you ever wondered why many professional bloggers come from the Midwest, South Pacific Northwest, Colorado, Texas or international cities, would Chiang Mai or Manila? Lower living costs! It's much easier to be a pro blogger if you live in a cheap area. Only a fool would try to blog for a lifetime in San Francisco, Manhattan, London, Paris, or Hong Kong. If you find such fools, follow them, because they've beaten some insurmountable odds and probably have something worth reading. Example #1: 100,000 pages per month, 3 years of experience key points in the chart * With about \$51,144 in annual income, this blogger lives a comfortable life in Portland, Oregon. She blends lifestyle design and personal finances blogging topics together to reflect her personality. * She found a product she loves, which generates most of her income. Once you have found that the perfect product that fits well with your ongoing content, selling the product becomes easy. The only risk is the concentration of the product. If the product changes its terms or goes out of business, it is out of luck. * This blogger has also found corporate consulting work because of the content of her blog. She writes articles for a corporate blog, edits articles for another corporate blog, and not additional additional writing/editing for various customers. Her income divided between her blog, and consulting for others is a balanced 50/50. She writes articles for a corporate blog, edits articles for another corporate blog, and does not write additional book/editing for various clients. She loves the freedom of not having a structured 9-to-5! Example #2: 300,000 pages per month, 4.5 years of experience key points in the chart * This blogger makes more money from consulting than from blogging. Once you become a recognized brand in your niche, corporations will contact you for online marketing, content marketing, and writing expertise. Individuals will arrive for your specific advice, as well as if you put a consulting page. Corporate freelance opportunities are the biggest X Factor I didn't anticipate when I quit my day job in 2012. But it makes sense. * The key to generating sustainable online revenue is to find affiliate partnerships for the products you use and love. If you can provide a 1-2 combo by providing value-added content that answers an important question while also providing an action product to use, you've got yourself a home run. Each unique product I highlight on FS is either free or will save readers time and money. * There's nothing better than selling your own product that you've spent your heart and soul creating. You're the product expert. You're the sales selling easier. I know my severance bargaining card works because I'm still getting benefits from it four years later. Not only did they have several dozen people writing in to thank me for the resource, I consulted with a few dozen more people about breaking free from their jobs with money in their pockets. Your product can and will act as a lead generator for any consulting services you may wish to provide. It's a lot of work, but helping people with a certain 1X1 problem is extremely rewarding. * \$151,200 in blogging revenue and \$337,200 in total income might sound impossible to achieve, but I can assure you that the vast majority of blogs that generate 300,000 to 500,000 page views per month as in this example earn similar amounts. You do more than bankers, technicians, lawyers, politicians, doctors, journalists and company executives. However, no one has any idea because blogging is not taught in school and gets very little respect as a profession. Your key is to generate as much traffic as possible by writing as interesting and useful content as possible. Unfortunately, great content does not sell. Those who are the most often get the most traffic, even if their content is not as good. Example #3: 1,000,000 page views per month, 10 years of experience key points in the chart * the main driver of revenue growth is the affiliate partnership, which has more than four times from the second example due to strong traffic, better terms due, and more focused topics refers to the related product. CPC/RPM revenue has not increased at the same rate as increased traffic because the quality of ads/products are not as good. Increasing ad blocking software may also be part of slowing growth. * Having a large platform under a strong brand, a new product can easily generate \$2,000+ per month, for example, XYZ for dummies series of books. An online platform can have an infinite amount of product. The only compulsion is one's effort and time. * Corporate consulting activity goes down because the blogger is already making \$90,000+ from his website. All non-blogging related income activity is made entirely for fun. He now charges \$1,000-\$2,500 to write a corporate article where he also offers a linkback to generate traffic to the article. 1X1 career coaching income goes up as individual clients seek this blogger's expertise after 10 years of blogging and publishing over 1800 articles. * This pro blogger has introduced a podcast to provide more color and personality for his content. He recognizes that there are millions of people who only listen to podcasts, which he would like to connect with. Given its blog traffic and brand set, advertisers easily pay \$1,000-\$2,000 per 15-episode for 20 minutes. If the blogger produces just one episode a week, he will make an additional \$52,000 from his work, instead of the \$12,000 I estimated here. * With over \$1,000,000 a year in earning work 25 hours a week, the blogger has the freedom to do whatever he wants whenever he wants. He practices Stealth Wealth because very few people will relate to such a level of income, or very few people will think they make such a sum from a blog. The general trend is to try to discredit someone you don't believe. It is much better to blend in and continue the belief that blogging may not be a true profession. Example #4: 4,000,000 pages a month food blogger and you thought you couldn't make big bucks being a food blogger. Check out the Pinch from Yum's income statement for a month. It's not bad. Who knew that taking pictures of food and writing about recipes could be so profitable? Based on a real example. Transition into Blogging When I left my job in 2012, my blog was generating about \$5,000 a month. Not bad, but not too much if you have a \$4,300-a-month mortgage. However, with my passive income streams set of about \$6,800 a month and a six-digit separation check, I had little pressure to try and monetize this site. If I had done this, I'm pretty sure the articles would have been much less because I would probably have focused on writing a bunch of credit card review posts. Unless you've been able to negotiate an enormous separation package, I don't recommend anyone just leave them the rent to try and become a professional blogger. Based on my experience, and the experience of dozens of other professional bloggers I know, it takes a minimum of a year or more likely two years to make any kind of income (\$1,000/month). But after that, the sky is the limit! Given that it will probably take two years to earn enough to pay the mortgage or job, I suggest everyone starts a site while working a full-time job. No one will deny you the freedom to write your personal journal online because of the First Amendment. And if you feel they will, write with a pseudonym. Obviously, don't write about your employer, share information from within, or denounce people you work with. Be positive and focus on a different niche. Consider two years as a low-risk disadvantage disengagement period for whether you can really keep up with the writing program. See if you like the process. For me, progress is exciting. The upside is very rarely capped on the internet because the demand curve is so high. Write how you feel strongly about After spending 13 years working in Equities/Investment Banking and getting my MBA, it was very easy to write about investing in public markets. Ironically, I didn't write much about investing until after I left work in 2012 because I didn't want to risk blowing myself to work if there was some kind of conflict of interest. Instead, I wrote a lot about real estate investments and being an owner. When you write from experience, writing becomes much easier. You don't have to do as much research or do things as you go along. You can draw from real-life examples to share your advice. Writing from experience also gives you much more authority than writing through pontification. Today, it is not enough to just report news and interview a few sources. Consumers also want to hear your opinion on this topic. Part of the reason the journalism industry is getting decimated is because journalists can't throw in their own personal analysis for fear of being biased. They always have an opinion supported by facts, but thanks to the plethora of ways in which we can now consume news, for example, Twitter, reason has become a commodity. Therefore, in order to prosper, you must have an opinion, supported with an enlightening analysis. Anyone reading Financial Samurai for at least a month knows that I am very opinionated about certain topics. For example, I don't think anyone should contribute to a Roth IRA before first maxing out their 401 (k). I think the reason so many of us are spoiled or clueless about money is because we haven't suffered enough or seen real suffering from people all over the world. I think getting a 30-year mortgage is a loss, because interest rates are likely to be low for the rest of our lives. During the debate between whether to open the economy and keep it closed during the pandemic, that is indeed the survival of the richest and those who are already rich and who keep on getting paid, who are fine with an indefinite lock. I might disagree with my views, but I provide some very in-depth analysis as to why I think the way I do based on experience. Only when based on experience and strong interest you will be able to maintain a consistent production schedule. Not only will you be able to write constantly, you will also be able to write more affectionately. No tears in the writer, no tears in the reader, says one. Readers can tell when you're shipping in or putting everything you have in your craft. As your site grows, you need to grow a thick skin and embrace those who dissent. Once you start getting nasty comments or hate mail, you know you've arrived! Internet leverage for everything at the age of 43, I'm lucky enough to clearly remember what life was like before the internet. Life's much better now. The amount of free and useful information online is amazing. What used to take 10 hours to write could only take two hours now, thanks to the ease of finding sources. It used to take days to get written mail delivered or a stock confirmation. Now, communication and trade confirmations are instantaneous. There's nothing better than starting your own website to own the online brand and earn extra revenue on the side. Why should LinkedIn, FB, and Twitter profit on you? With your own website you can potentially connect millions of people online, sell a product, sell the product to someone else, make passive income and find a lot of new opportunities for consulting and FT work. Use Bluehost to host your site. What used to cost thousands of dollars and days of time now can be done for much less in just 15 minutes. Once you own your own website, it's much easier to get a job, sell a product and tell your story. You never know where the trip will take you!
